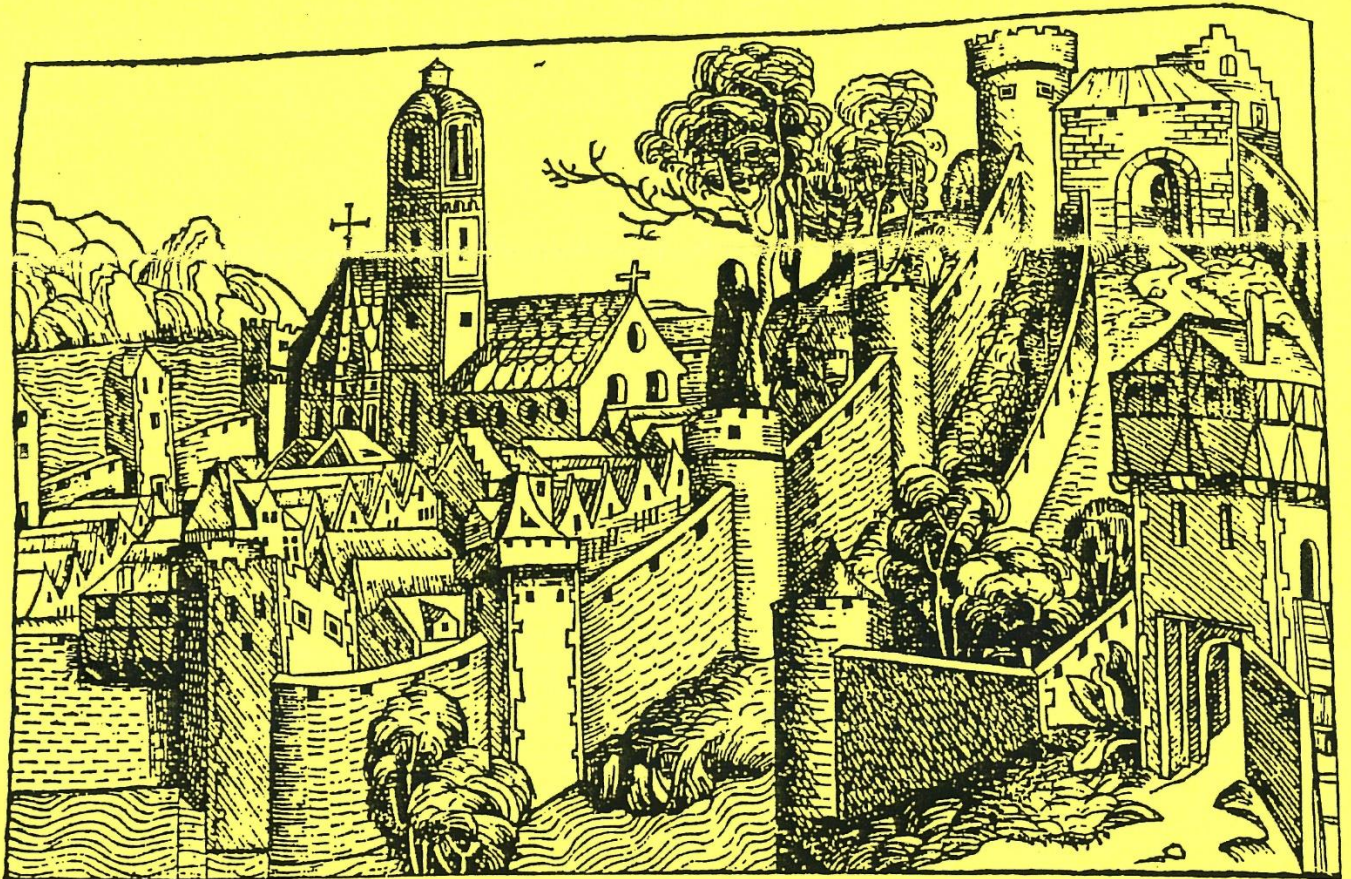


The illustration shows a view of Athens by Michael Wolgemuth, from Hartmann Schedel, Liber Chronicarum, Nürnberg, 1493.
