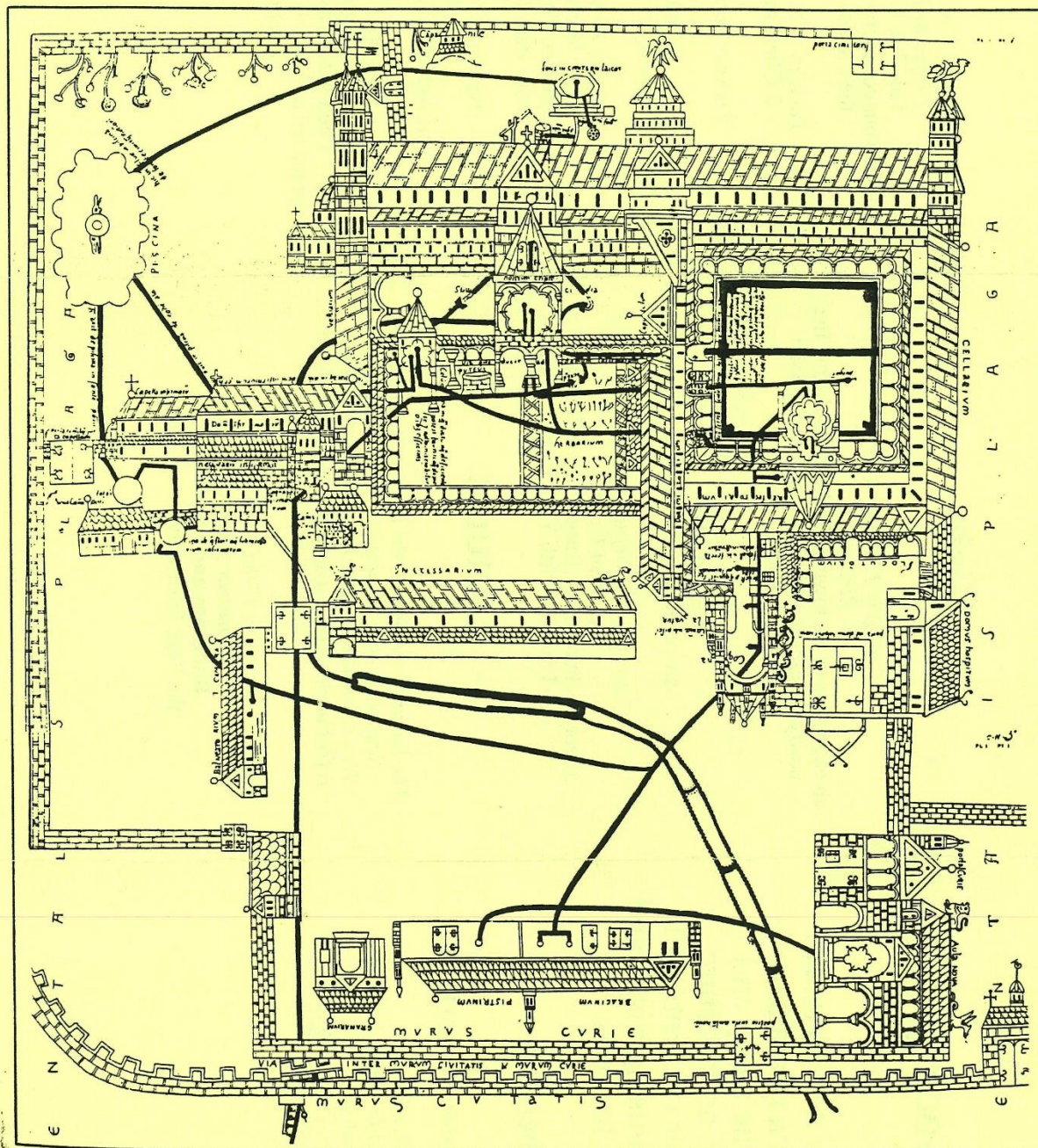


a 12th-century drawing of Canterbury Cathedral, showing water supply and drains
